

# Kit Info

## The Basics

This kit is designed to pin/fruit within 10 days of arrival. Look for tiny white specks all over the surface of your kit. These are your baby mushrooms.



If they don't look like this yet, they will soon!

They will grow into a mature flush of mushrooms over the next week so long as you keep the kit in a space that averages temperatures in the 60s-70s Fahrenheit. For the mushrooms, indirect light with a little airflow is better than a closed space such as a closet.



## Knowing when it's time to harvest

Generally, these mushrooms will grow for about a week until they hit peak maturity. After this point, the flesh will begin to soften and lose density. Here is a visual reference of peak maturity. The best time to harvest is at this stage of maturity or slightly before this point.

## After your first harvest

Once you've harvested your first flush, you can pour 1 cup of water into your kit. Let it soak for about an hour and then pour off the excess water. From that point on, you can mist the surface every other day until more mushrooms grow.

PRO TIP: YOUR GOAL IS TO WATER THE SURFACE OF THE SUBSTRATE, NOT THE MUSHROOMS OR PINS.



Dry your mushrooms to "cracker dry" to ensure the best quality.
